JCL in liquidation

JCL Marine and its subsidiary Moonraker MotorYachts have gone into liquidation with debts totalling £1.43 million.

Creditors were told at a meeting in London on 18 November that the deficiency was likely to be reduced by about £600,000. Customers who had paid for incomplete yachts would be allowed to remove them provided the payments covered work already completed. Kidsons, the London chartered accountants, have been appointed liquidators.

The businesses formed part of the empire of Lotus Car boss Colin Chapman. JCL produced the Marauder, Mystere, Mirage and Mamba yachts, and its subsidiary built the Moonraker range.
